

In WWII the British Long Range Desert Group (LRDG) used two Waco biplanes along with many Chevrolet and Ford trucks to conduct hit and run raids in the deserts of northern Africa. Groups discussion line, so some are aware of this group. I encourage you to search out readings on the LRDG. It is fascinating and exciting


On a safety note, I see that I have now accumulated about a dozen LIPO batteries and I NEED to take pains to consider safe storage more actively. I am in the process of storing them at 50% charge. I can run a motor to get the battery down there, or I can use a particular charger I have that will perform discharging

I have yet to figure out if I should put each one in a LIPO bag or something like that. Should a person go all the way to bring one of those cabinets for flammable items like paint?

Fellow club member Dave Popelka dis-recommends Lipo bags. "They do not work and could create a dangerous condition in your home. I have started storing my Lipos (ten 5-amp batteries) in concrete blocks in my garage."







"I place the lipos inside the block cavities and then place sand filled large ziplock bags on top of the cavities. If a lipo should happen to go off, it will melt the ziplock and dump the sand into the cavity."


