It is with a heavy heart that we must pass along sad news regarding the discontinuance of THE TESTOR CORPORATION product brands to all our international friends and associates.

As many of you know THE TESTOR CORPORATION has been under the direction of the RUST-OLEUM CORPORATION, who we have worked with for several years. Regrettably we were informed that RUST-OLEUM have determined it is no longer feasible to maintain the TESTOR brands.

According to RUST-OLEUM The requirements for labeling, special handling and smaller production runs have made the ongoing sale of TESTOR brands too costly to continue. RUST-OLEUM will be phasing out of the "Hobby and Craft Industry".

RUST-OLEUM has informed us that they will not accept or ship any further TESTOR brand orders overseas after November 2019.

We can however accept and ship one last order for TESTOR brands to help assist any distributor wishing to balance their existing inventory. Please note that any last orders must be received no later than Thursday October 31st, for shipment "as ready".

We sincerely regret having to pass along this unfortunate news. At the same time, we would like to thank everyone for their years of loyalty to THE TESTOR CORPORATION and their related brands
