Discussion centered around the proposed legislation regarding drones in the Iowa Legislature. Craig has spoken with a legislator Hogg who has written the bill. Kent (who is an AMA Assistant area v.p.) is keeping watch for AMA. Craig has spoken with legislator Deyoe and he is skeptical it would make it through the funnel. We are wondering what the stimulus for this has been. 3rd week in Feb and a date in March are dates for the legislature.

#### **The Scrap Bin**

A flash back. That is what happened to me last Monday. There was a call from Lionel in New Jersey. He was interested in one of Milford Nessa's planes. He had found the PDF document I made when I was helping Milford sell his planes. I do not really know how many years ago that was, but I had to say that those were all gone. "What were you interested in?," I asked. "The T-28., he said. Wow! That is hanging in my garage!

The T-28 is probably a Dave Platt kit model. Milford bought it to look at, so the slight damage was there when he bought it. I told Lionel he could have it for shipping. We will see how that plays out.

I have a problem; self-created, of course. I have nearly finished recovering a Goldberg Cub. It had no cowling and I was not sure (well, I forgot) that a cowling that Tower Hobbies has is said to fit. So, I ordered the longer version for 4-strokes from Fiberglass Specialties. I should have asked if it could be shortened - it really cannot.

Now I have to decide whether to extend the engine to fit the long cowl, or just eat it and get the Tower cowl. The one problem I see with extending the engine is that it will not really be possible to alter the mounting holes so that the crankshaft exit from the cowl as high as it should be.

Because of the firewall tilt, it will come out 1/8"-3/16" low. Maybe that won't matter. It will also create a need for tail weight. I already recovered it, though, and I do not really want to dig into it. Like I said, a problem of my own creation.

I will have these parts at the meeting for everyone to look over and want you to give me your thoughts on what I should do with it.
