

The Scrap Bin by Denny Goodrich

I have a problem that I would like have your input on for fixing - or doing nothing.

At the fall auction I bought a big old biplane. Turns out it is a Concept Models 1/4-scale Fleet biplane. The span of the top wing is about 83". Long by standards of my other models. It is is good enough shape to merit a rebuild. Most damage is small. I have uncovered (pun intended, of course!) several things about the top wing. There are two right hand panels. The rib bays outside the center section are supposed to be narrower, so this is not true on the left wing. No real problem except for deviation from scale and NN-strut placement.

The wing is supposed to be three pieces, joined by 3/16" plywood joiners inserted into the hollow box team spars. However, the builder glued the tongues in! The reason I would like to have them separable is that it is possible to keep the rigging between the upper and lower wings intact when disassembled.

Should I cut the wings apart, I would have to dig and drill out the box spar to accept new plywood joiners. I do not know what glue was used, but I suspect epoxy. The box spar is built up with spruce top and bottom and 1/16" ply sides, or shear webbing.

I look forward to your comments at the meeting and delivered other ways.
