Hate to say this, but I saw snow again and could hardly see through it. Oh wait a minute, that was a snow globe, not a crystal ball. Whew, had me worried for a minute.

Last month I finished the tail feathers on my Stinger 120. Wing was next, but I only did about a third of it, then switched to work on the fuselage. Wanted to make sure the fuselage was done ahead of the wing so alignment was correct for both the wing and the fuselage. Surprisingly everything lined up per the plans. I taped fishing line to the center mark at the firewall and stretched it back to the center of the tail. Checked markers in between and all was good. Yeah!

Now I have returned to finish the wing. Kind of a slow process working with foam, but I am surprised at how strong the wing is for as light as it is. Sheeting took more time than I'd thought, but for me, using white glue seemed to work better. Waiting 24 hours for the glue to fully cure seems like an eternity. As of now, the leading edge of the wing is drying and then needs to be shaped. Cap strips, ailerons, servo cavities, etc are next. More to follow next month.

Flying season has arrived so be sure you have paid your AMA dues as well as our club dues. (And remember the AMA number and FAA numbers to be included on planes! Ed.) Safety is of the utmost importance, so please be sure to check your planes over, field equipment, cycle batteries, etc. And have fun!


From the Rockwell Collins Model Aviators
