

field. But would the defects in the levee be topped? The flood gauges were watched with apprehension. Meanwhile, the mowers were moved to the roadside high ground and the benches were rounded up and bound together.

Then on Sunday, August 30, 2015, one week before the Multi-Fly, the Skunk river overflowed into the field above us, sending water cascading
